


ARROWHEAD

The shape I had been doodling for many weeks, the first prototype was drawn up, cut and sewn up in one evening. It was based on a 25cm square. To scale it up is a very simple geometric exercise. I have just finished one on a 40cm grid and am planning a 100cm scale.
